# Appendix B: Guidance on Survivor Eligibility for Riders

## Law Enforcement United Survivor Eligibility Status Explanation

### **Direct Survivor**

- Immediate household of the fallen
  - Spouse
  - Significant other
  - o Children/stepchildren
- Immediate family member of the fallen
  - o Parent
  - Sibling
  - Grandparent
  - o In-law
  - Guardian

#### **Indirect Survivor**

- Co-worker to the fallen
- Other agencies involved with fallen

\*These are guidelines only. Each Division has the authority to classify a survivor's status based on the established criteria above. Extenuating circumstances outside these parameters will be submitted to the National Board who retains the right to approve, deny, or change a division's decision based on further information received during any appeal process. Should one Division make the decision that an applicant is not a survivor and that applicant request to ride with another Division, no Division will have the authority to approve, once denied by another Division.

Any divisions with eligibility decisions (approval/denial) should be communicated to National Board for situational awareness across all divisions

## **Appeal Process**
